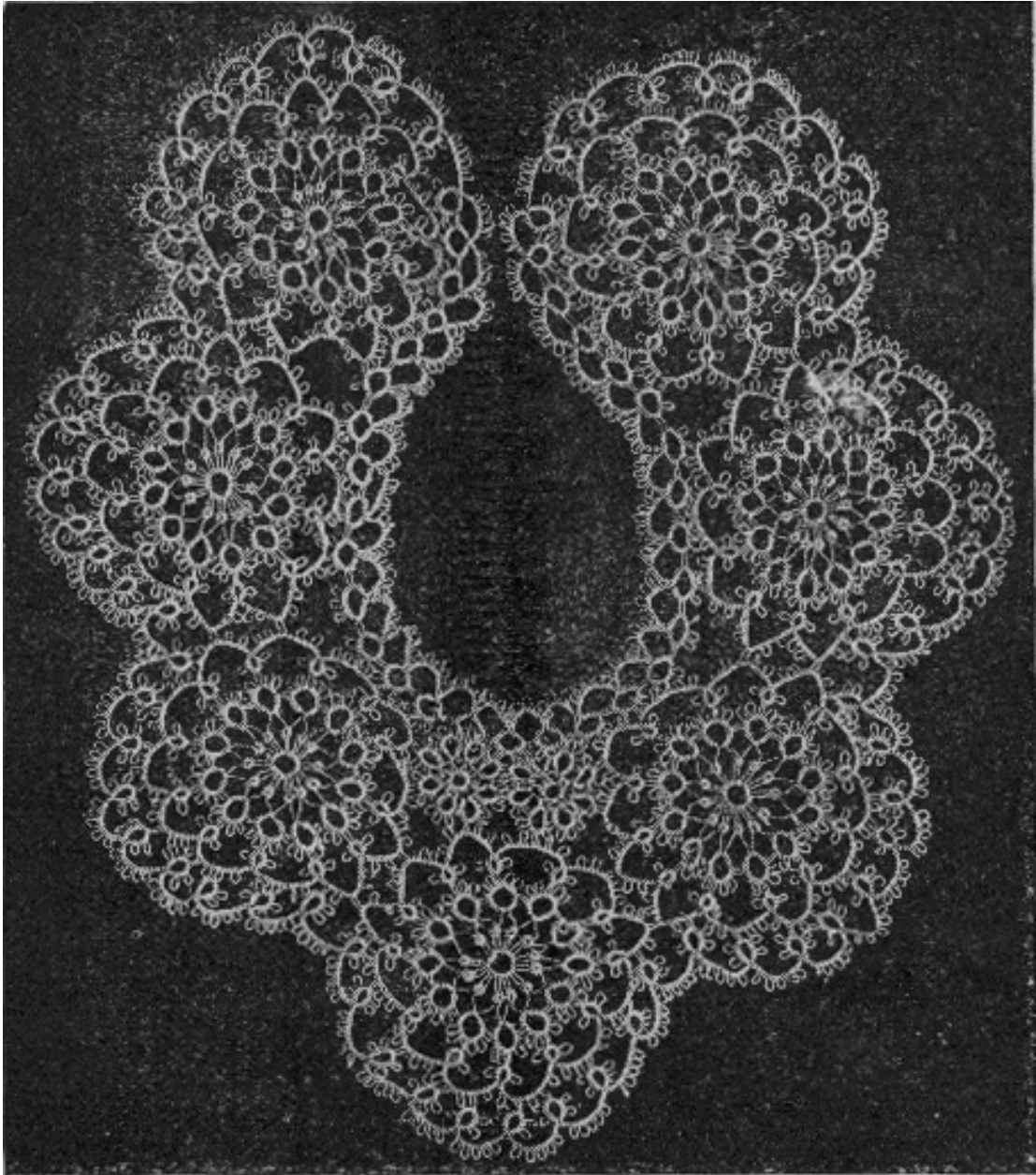


# Child's Round Yoke

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"-"=picot

"+"=join >

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

This very pretty round yoke or collar has medallions made as directed in 1st and 2nd rows of bonnet.

R: 3-3+(to middle p of r of medallion)3-3, cl, rw

CH 3-3-3-3-3-3, rw

Repeat around, joining last chain at base of 1st ring.

Make a 2nd medallion in the same way, joining to 1st by middle picots of 2 consecutive chains; join 3rd medallion to 2nd, by middle picot of 2 chains, leaving 3 free chains above and 5 below; 4th to 3rd in same way; 5th to 4th, leaving 2 free chains of the latter above and 6 below; 6th to 5th same as 3rd to 2nd, and 7th to 6th, leaving 3 free chains of the latter above.

Fill the space above 4th medallion with 2 medallions made as follows:

R: 1-2-2-2-2-2-2-1, cl, draw thread through picot

(close to joining)R: 4-2-2-2-2-4, cl, join to next picot of center ring.

Make another ring, joining to 1st side picot of preceding ring; another, joining to last as directed and by middle picot to 4th picot of 2nd free chain of 3rd medallion; join next ring by middle picot to middle picot of 3rd free chain of same medallion, make a free ring, join middle picot of next ring to middle picot of 1st free chain of 4th medallion, make 2 more free rings, joining last to 1st, and fasten off. Make a 2nd medallion, joining on other side as directed, and by last 2 free rings to corresponding rings of 1st medallion.

For the edge:

R: 5-3-3+(to 2nd p of 1st ch at top[the 4th ch, counting back from upper joining] of 1st medallion)3-3-5, cl, rw

CH: 3-2-2-2-2-3, rw

R: 5+(to last p of prev r)3-3+(to middle p to 4th p of same ch)3-3-5, cl, rw

CH: 3-2-2-2-2-3, rw

R: 5+(to last p of prev r)3-3+(to middle p of next ch of same medallion)3-3-5, cl, rw

Join a ring to 3rd and 5th picots of next chain(always alternating rings and chains, as described, and joining each ring to preceding) join a ring to middle picot of next chain, and 1 ring to 1st free chain of next or 2nd medallion, a ring to 2nd and 3rd picots of next chain and 1 to next, Make a free ring.

Join a ring to 3rd and 5th picots of 1st free chain of next medallion

Join a ring to 2nd picot of next chain

Join a ring at top of medallion

Join a ring between medallion and at top of 2nd medallion

Join a ring to 4th picot of next chain

Join rings to 1st and 3rd picots of next chain

Make a free ring, and continue as directed, joining last 2 rings to 2nd and 4th of 4th chain of 7th medallion; then around the lower part of collar

CH: 3-2-2-2-2-3, rw

R: 3-3-3+(to 2nd p of next ch)3-3-3, cl, rw

CH: 3-2-2-2-2-3, rw

R: 3-3-3+(to 4th p of same ch)3-3-3, cl, rw

CH: 3-2-2-2-2-3, rw

R: 3-3-3+(to middle p of next ch)3-3-3, cl, rw

\*(Join 2 rings to next chain, and 1 ring to next chain) twice

Join a ring to 1st picot of next chain

Join a ring to last picot of next chain(on 6th medallion)

Join a ring to middle picot of next chain<

Repeat from \* twice, then around 4th medallion

Join a ring to next chain

Join 2 rings to each of next 2 chains

Join a ring to each of next 2 chains

Join a ring to 1st of next chain and 5th of next chain

On following medallion, join a ring to next chain, and again repeat from  
\*, ending the row as begun.
