## Abbreviations:

R=ring

"-"=picot

clr=close ring

SR=split ring

"+"=join

CH=chain

RW=rw

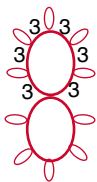
"--"=long picot

SS=switch shuttles

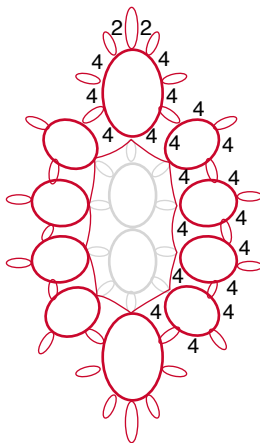


### Center Rings:

R: 3-3-3-3-3-3, clr, rw

R: 3-3-3-3-3-3, clr

Tie and work in ends.



### Outer Rings:

Join shuttle thread to middle picot of ring of center.

R: 4-4-4-2--2-4-4-4, clr. Leave 1/4 inch space of thread and join to next picot of center ring.

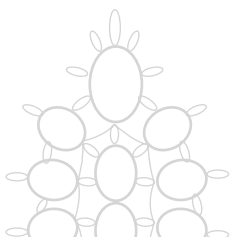
R: 4+(to last p of prev R)4-4-4, clr. Join thread to same picot at base of ring to secure. Leave 1/4 inch space of thread and join to next picot.

Make another ring as before.

Make another ring as before, but connect to first free picot of next center ring.. Repeat one more ring.

Make a large ring as the first ring in this row.

This completes half around. Continue and join last ring to first. Tie and work in ends.



Side Leaves: load two shuttles using CTM(continuous thread method)

R: 4-4, clr

CH: 4, SS

R: 3-3-3-3, clr

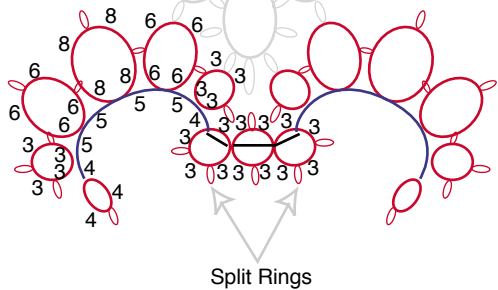
CH: 5, SS

R: 6+(to last p of prev R)6-6-6, clr

CH: 5, SS

R: 8+(to last p of prev R)8-8-8, clr

CH: 5, SS



Split Rings

R: 6+(to last p of prev R)6+(to middle p of 4th small R of oval motif)6-6, clr

CH: 5, SS

R: 3+(to last p of prev R)3+(to 3rd p of large R of oval motif)3-3, clr

CH: 4

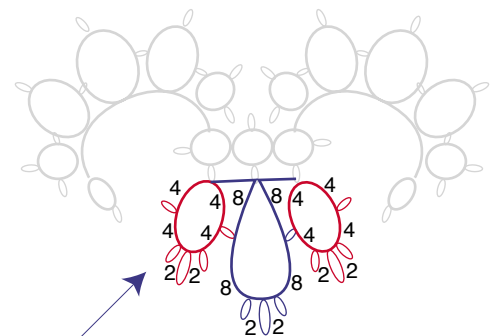
SR: 3/3-3-3, clr

SR: 3-3/3-3, clr

SR: 3/3-3-3, clr

Repeat other side leaf in reverse order. Be sure to join to picots of oval motif.

Tie and work in ends.



Lower Tail: join both shuttle threads to bottom free picot of first SR.

R: 4-4-2--2-4-4, clr, do not rw

CH: 5, join to free picot of next SR

CH: 8+(to last p of prev R)8-2--2-8-8+(to same p of SR)

CH: 5, join to free picot of next SR, do not rw

R: 4+(to last p of adj CH)4-2--2-4-4, clr

Tie and work in ends.
