Load shuttle with red thread of choice. Do not cut thread from ball. Sample was made with Coats and Clark size 80 cotton.

Load shuttle with purple thread of choice. Sample was made with C&C varigated size 80 cotton

R: 1-1-1-1-1-1-1, CLR

Leave a space of thread. Make several of these rings in a long line. Leave thread ends to attach to the hat.
