

# Trefoil Snowflake

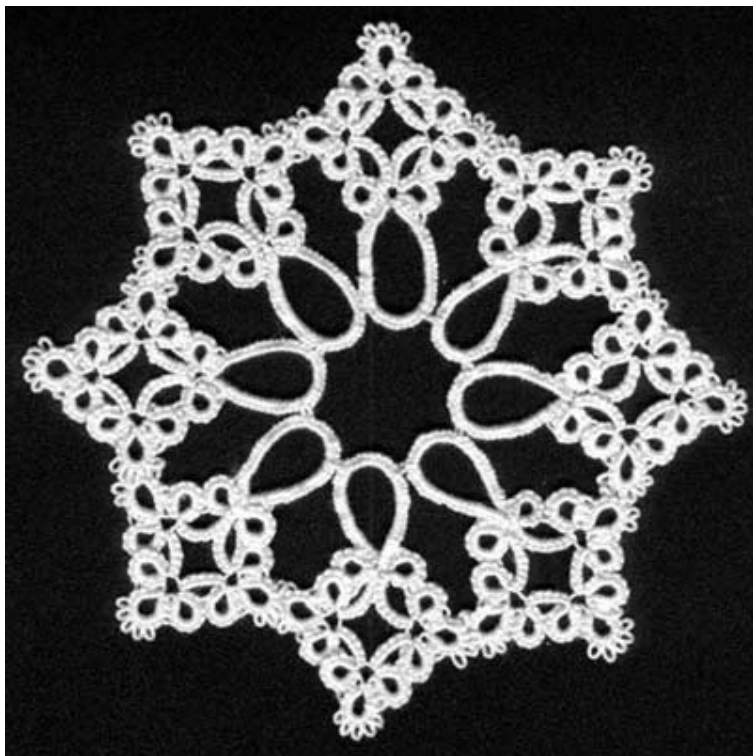

## Symbols for text pattern:

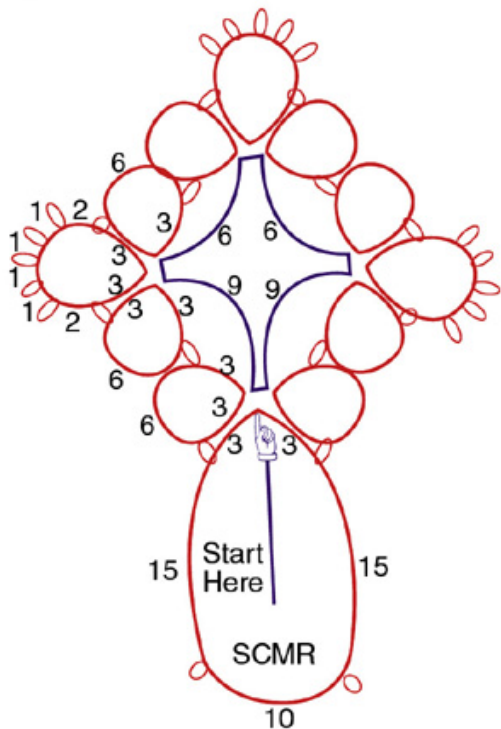
R=ring  
 "-"=picot  
 B=bead  
 clr=close ring  
 work  
 CTM=Continuous Thread Method

CH=chain  
 "--"=long picot  
 "+"=join  
 rw=re      verse

Load 2 shuttles with thread. CTM. Each section is worked individually and joined to previous motifs when indicated. 8 joined motifs in all. The very large ring doesn't have to be a SCMR. It can be executed as a regular large ring. I just used the SCMR to make it easier on my hands and more control.



Sample is made of white Cebelia cotton thread size 20.



R: 3-6-3, cl r  
 SCMR: 3+(to last p of prev r)15-10-15-3, cl r  
 R: 3+(to last p of prev r)6-3, cl r, rw  
 CH: 9, rw  
 Cloverleaf:  
 R: 3+(to last p of prev r)6-3, cl r  
 R: 3+(to last p of prev r)2-1-1-1-1-2-3, cl r  
 R: 3+(to last p of prev r)6-3, cl r, rw  
 CH: 6, rw  
 Make another cloverleaf as instructed before. rw  
 CH: 6, rw  
 Make another cloverleaf as instructed before. rw  
 CH: 9, rw  
 R: 3+(to last p of prev r)6+(to first p of SCMR)3, cl r  
 Tie and work in ends.
