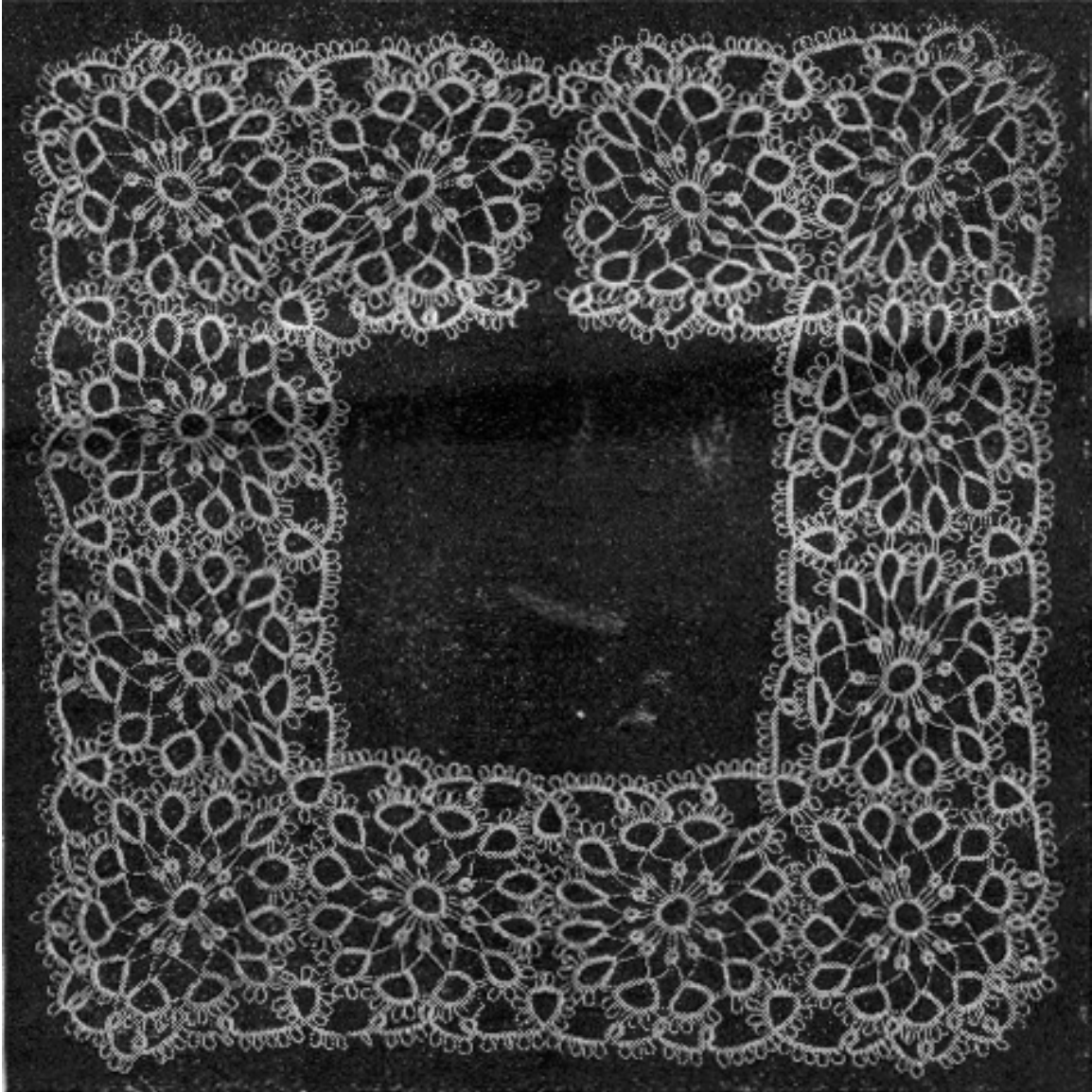


# Child's Square Yoke

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"- "=picot

"+"=join

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

This square yoke is composed of medallions made like those of the bonnet. Join 2 medallions by middle picots of 2 consecutive rings; join 3rd medallion to 2nd, leaving 1 free ring of latter between, so that a corner

of 3 medallions is formed; join 4th and 5th medallions as you did the 2nd, then form the 2<sup>nd</sup> corner, and repeat until you have formed the square of 12 medallions. Do not join last medallion to 1st.

For the inner edge:

R: 3-3+(to middle p of 4th r from inner joining of 1st medallion)3-3, cl, rw

\*CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to p joining the 2 rings of medallion)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to middle p of next r of medallion)4, cl, rw

Repeat from \* 1 time.

CH: 2-2-2-2-2-2, rw

Large R: 2-2-2-2+(to middle p of next r of 1st medallion)2-2+(to middle p of free r of corner or 2nd medallion)2-2+(to middle p of 1st free r of 3rd medallion)2-2-2-2, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to middle p of next r)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to p which joins 2 rings of medallion)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to middle p of next r)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2-2-2, rw

Large R: 2-2-2-2+(to middle p of next r of 3rd medallion)2-2-2+(to middle p of 1st free r of 4th medallion)2-2-2-2, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to middle p of next r)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to p between rings)4, cl, rw

CH: 2-2-2-2, rw

R: 4+(to middle p of next r)4, cl, rw >

Repeat from last \*, ending row as begun.

Make the outer edge in the same way, with large rings between medallions, and 3 small rings, with short chains between, over each medallion except the corners, make 9 small rings, with short chains between, joining a small ring to middle picot of ring of medallion and between rings, alternately.
