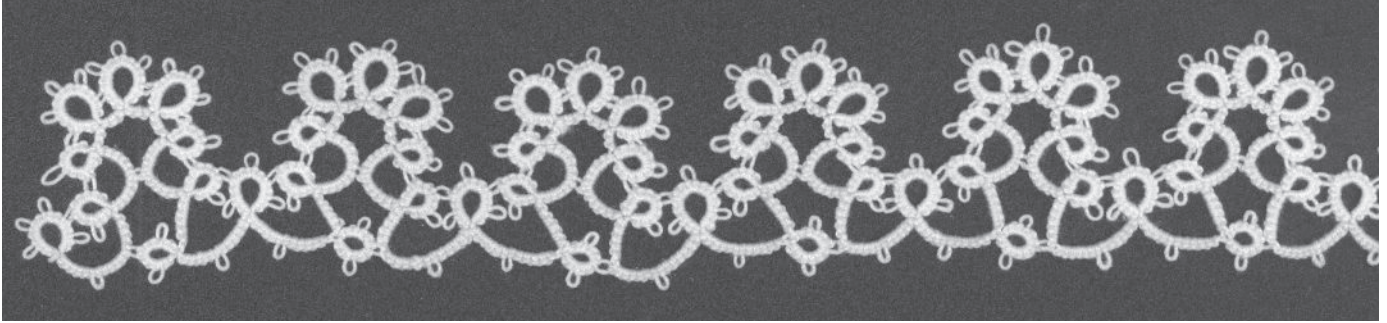


CROWNING GLORY EDGING



Sample made of DMC Cebelia cotton size 30. Measures 3cm(1.25 inches) wide

Text Abbreviations:
 R=ring
 CLR=close ring
 RW=reverse work
 SLT=shoe lace trick

"-"=picot
 "--"=long picot
 "+"=joining picot

Diagram Abbreviations:

○ =ring
 — =chain
 | =picot
 + =joining picot

Requires one shuttle and one ball. Load one shuttle with desired thread, do not cut thread off ball. CTM(continuous thread method). When using the SLT, before making a ring, this creates a point to the chain rather than round, and only one shuttle is required with the ball instead of two shuttles. This is the desired effect, but not the only way to work this pattern.

RA: 3-3-3-3-3, CLR, RW

*CH: 6-6, SLT

RB: 3-3-3-3, SLT

CH: 6, RW

RC: 3-3+(to 4th p of RA)3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 6-6, RW

RD: 3+(to last p of RC)3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 3, RW

RE: 3+(to last p of RD)3-3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 3, RW

RF: 3+(to last p of RE)3-3-3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 3, RW

RG: 3+(to last p of RF)3-3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 3, RW

RH: 3+(to last p of RG)3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 6+(to adj chain)6, RW

RI: 3+(to last p of RH)3-3-3, CLR, RW

CH: 6+(lock join to middle p of RB)6-6, RW

RJ: 3-3+(to second p of RI)3-3-3-3, CLR, RW*

This completes one revolution to the pattern. Repeat from * to * for desired length.

Tie and work in ends.
