

# Santa Head Ornament

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## Abbreviations:

r=ring                    cl=close  
LR=large ring        sr=small r            ing  
ch=chain                rw=re                verse work  
"-="picot                "+"=joining to  
"--"=large picot

Load about a yard of peach thread in a shuttle.

Row #1 The eyes:

r, 12 picots sep by 1 ds, rw

Do a second ring same as before.

Tie and cut.

Row #2 The mustache: Use white thread.

Join ball and shuttle threads to 4th picot of ring on row #1

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(join to first and last picot of the two rings of row #1)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2

Join to 9th picot of next ring on row #1.

Tie and cut.

Row #3 The beard:

Use a ball and shuttle with white thread.

r, 4+(join to 5th picot of ring on row #1)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(join to next picot of ring on row #1)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(join to first picot of chain on row #2)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #2)4,

cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+( join to next picot of next chain on row #2)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #2)4,

cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(join to picot of ring on row #1 next to the join of chain

on row #2)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of ring on row #1)4,

cl r

Tie and cut.

Row #4 Bottom of beard:

r, 4+(join to last picot of second chain done in row #3)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #3)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #3)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #3)4, cl r, rw

ch, 2-2-2-2, rw

r, 4+(skip a picot and join to next picot of chain on row #3)4, cl r, rw

Tie and cut.

Row #5 Muff of the Hat:

Still using white thread for ball and shuttle,

r, 2-2+(join to last picot of last chain on row #3)2-2, cl r, rw

ch, 3-3, rw

r, 2+(join to last picot of prev. ring)2+(join to next free picot of ring on row #1)2-2, cl r, rw

ch, 3-3, rw

r, 2+(join to last picot of prev. ring)2+(join to last free picot of next ring on row #1)2-2, cl r, rw

r, 2+(join to last picot of prev. ring)2+(join to next free picot of ring on

row #1)2-2, cl r, rw



ch, 3-3, rw

r, 2+(join to last picot of prev. ring)2+(join to first picot of first chain made in row #3)2-2, cl r

Tie and cut.

Row #6 Hat:

Load about a yard and a half of red thread onto a shuttle.

Cloverleaf,

r, 3-3-3+(join to picot of first chain or row #5)3+(join to picot of next chain)3-3, cl r

r, 3+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3+(join to same picot of middle chain on row #5)3+(join to picot of next chain)3-3-3, cl r

r, 3+(join to last picot of prev. ring)3-3-3-3+(join to first picot of first ring made)3, cl r

Tie and cut.

For the hanger that looks like the ball of the hat:

Give yourself about two inches of thread space before the ring.

r, 6+(join to middle picot of last ring on row #6) 6, cl r

Cut thread two inches away from ring and tie to make the hanger.
