

# Spider & Web

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You can do several variations on this theme. I chose black thread, but you could use silver or clear thread for the spider web. Even add crystal beads for dew drops. And the spider can be in different colors of thread and beads. You can use the two motifs separate or together as shown. A nice way to display this is to applique it on a shoulder of an outfit. There are several possibilities. Be creative!

## Abbreviations:

r=ring            cl=close  
LR=large ring    sr=small r        ing  
ch=chain        rw=re            verse work  
"- "=picot        "+ "=joining to  
"-- "=large picot

## Spider Web doily pattern

This pattern uses a shuttle and ball thread. Load shuttle with black thread or thread of choice.

### Row#1

R: 4-4, cl r, rw

CH: 3-3, rw

Repeat ring and chain combination until there is 8 rings and chains. Tie and work in ends.

### Row#2

R: 4-4, cl r, rw, join to p of ring in Row#1

CH: 3-3-3, rw

Repeat all around. Tie and work in ends.

### Row#3

R: 4-4, cl r, rw

CH: 3+(to p of ring in row#2)3-3-3-3+(to p of next ring in row#2), rw

Repeat all around. Tie and work in ends.

### Row#4

R: 4-4, cl r, rw

CH: 3+(to p of ring in row#3)3-3-3-3-3-3+(to p of next ring in row#3), rw

Repeat all around. Tie and work in ends.

### Row#5

R: 4-4, cl r, rw

CH: 3+(to p of ring in row#4)3-3-3-3-3-3-3-3+(to p of next ring in row#4), rw

Repeat all around. Tie and work in ends.

### Row#6

R: 4-4, cl r, rw

CH: 3+(to p of ring in row#5)3-3-3-3-3-3-3-3-3-3+(to p of next ring in row#5), rw

Repeat all around. Tie and work in ends.

To make the web larger, just add more rows, but add two more picots to each new row. You may have to fudge and add three if necessary.



## Spider pattern

SR: 4-4, cl r, rw

LR: 5, very long picot, 5, very long picot, 10, very long picot, 5, very long picot, 5, cl r.

Tie and work in ends.

Using a needle and thread, tie at base of SR(head) Thread on 6 beads of your color choice. Attach to opposite end of LR(body). Thread on 6 more beads, attach to top of LR. Thread on 6 more beads, attach to bottom of LR. Tie and work in ends.
